

SPINS & NEEDLES PROJECT OF THE MONTH

PAPER BAG PIÑATA PARTY!

Materials

- * Paper bag
- * String
- * Scissors
- * Newspaper
- * Masking tape
- * Candies
- * Crepe/tissue paper
- * White glue
- * Ribbon
- * Paint and paintbrush (optional)
- * Construction paper (optional)



Instructions

1. **Poke a hole on either side of the bottom of the paper bag. Cut a piece of string 8 ft. long and double it on itself. Thread it through both holes and tie in a bow at top.**
2. **Stuff your bag with newspaper so that it is firm, leaving approx. 4" of room at top. Add your candies. Fold the top of bag over a few times and tape shut.**
3. **Decorate your bag with paint (optional) or with crepe paper. For crepe paper, cut out 5" strips. Add glue at top of strips and adhere horizontally and cover entire bag.**
4. **Cut your strips about 3" vertically to create a ruffled effect.**
5. **Tape strips of ribbon to the bottom of the bag. It's ready for hitting! THE END !**
